I have been revising the input/output extracodes in an attempt to include the improvements you suggested when I came to Harwell at the beginning of the month.

It is perfectly possible to limit the number of characters that will be read when reading a record, but it is very inconvenient allowing the programmer to specify the maximum number in the "Select input" extracode. The only practicable place to specify the limit is in the Read instruction itself. In the new version I am therefore proposing two extracodes:

1056 if you wish to set a limit
1057 if you require to go to the end, regardless.

In the old proposals, the binary/internal code information was given with every record, whether requested or not. This makes it difficult to find anywhere suitable for indicating whether the whole, or only part of the record is being read or written. In this new version there is a new extracode "Test binary/internal code" and the m.s. bit of the character count is now used for specifying whole or part records.

Your comments on this version would be very welcome.
